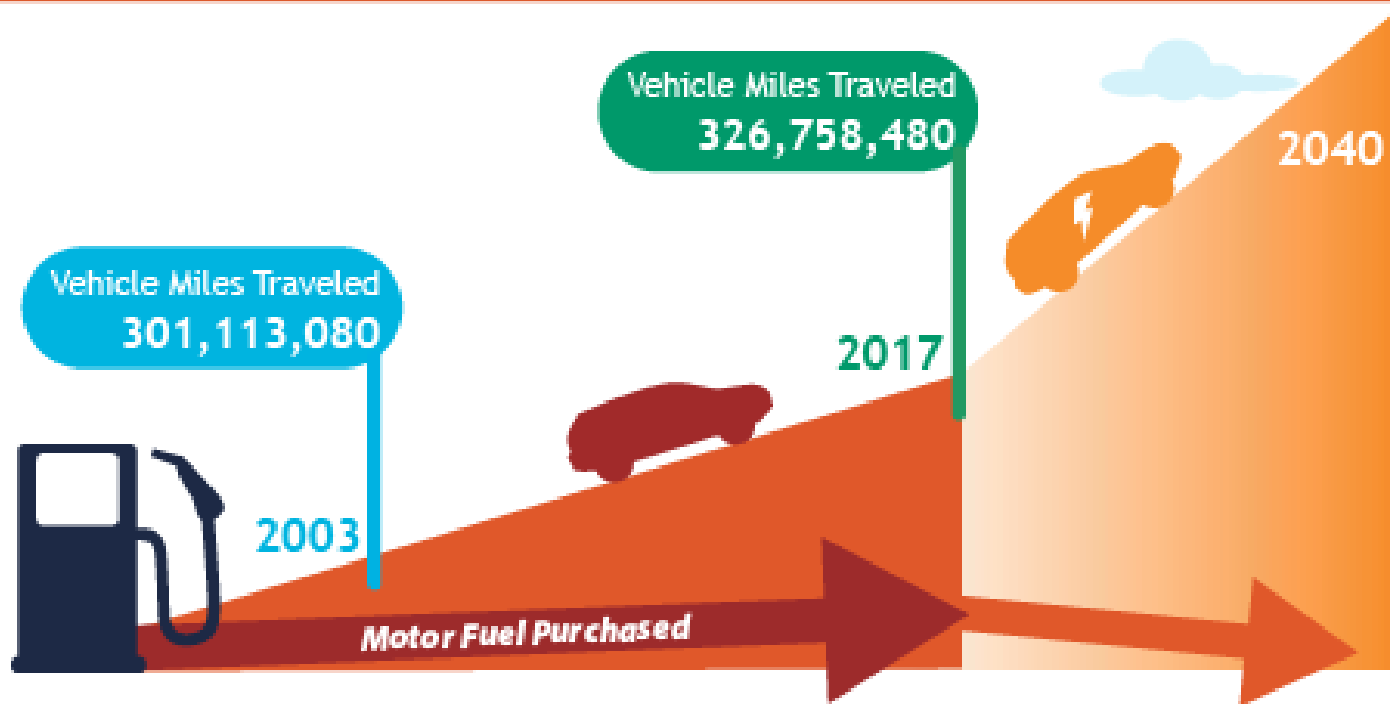

Motor Vehicle User Fee

- Governor's Proposal: \$0.18/gal increase as of July 1, 2019
 - 60/40 – ODOT/Locals
 - Ohio House: \$0.107/gal increase over two years
 - 55/45 – ODOT/Locals
 - Ohio Senate: ???
- 
- Approx. \$70 million for every 1-cent increase

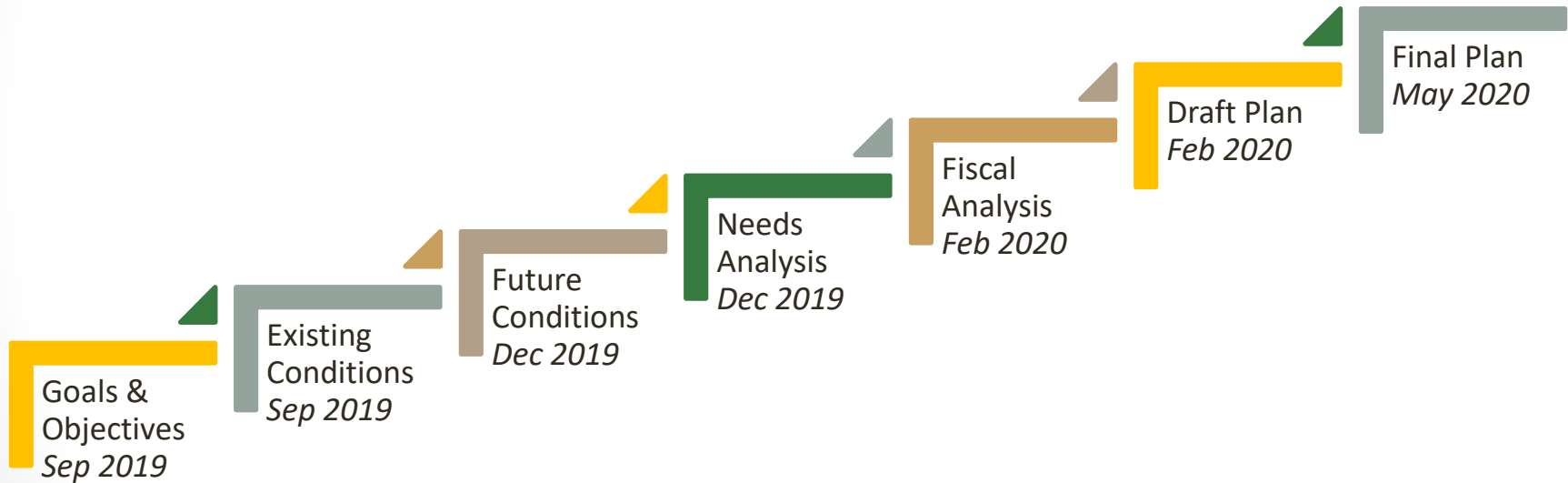

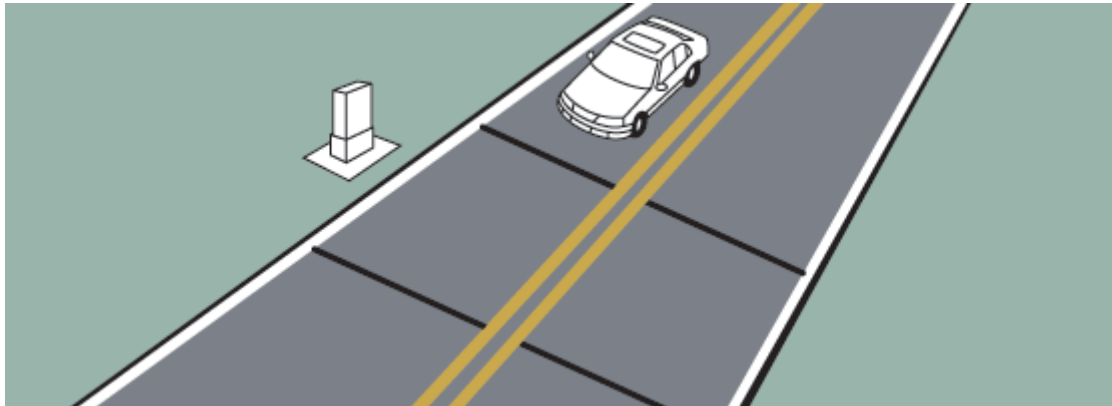


RTPO Long-Range Transportation Plan Update



Traffic Monitoring Program

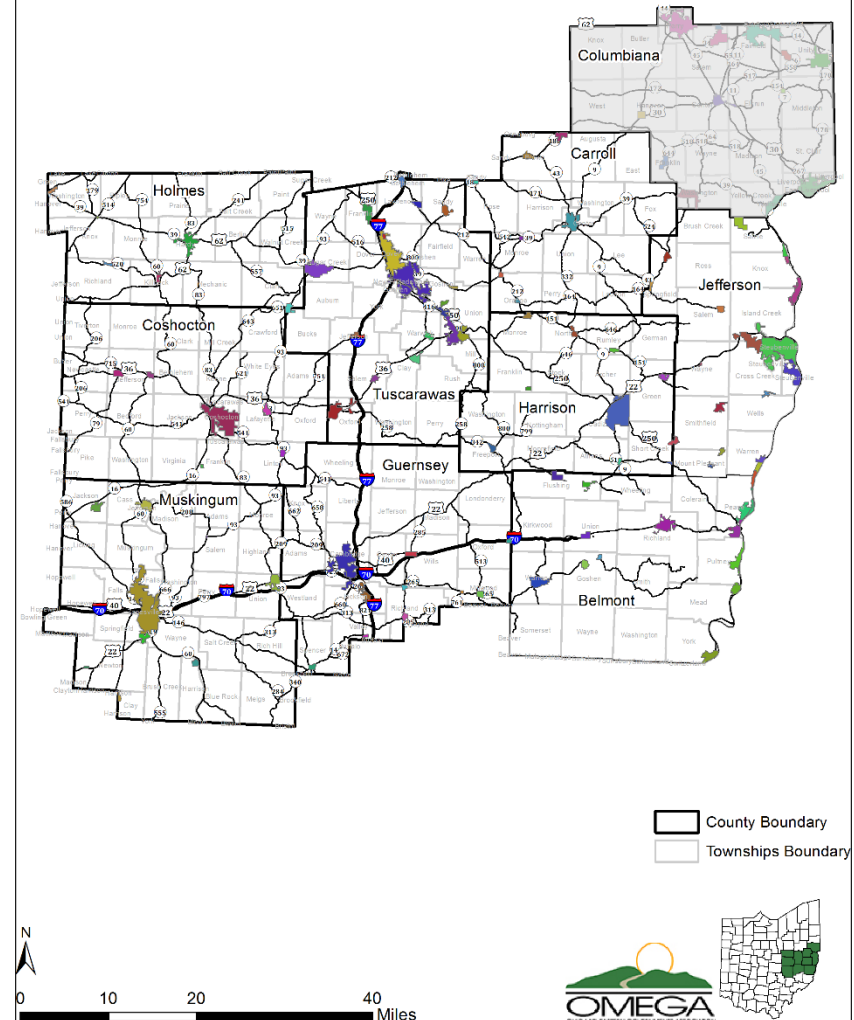
- Starting April/May 2019, OMEGA will be initiating a traffic monitoring program
 - 32-40 sites per year, and collected triennially
 - 4-5 sites per county
 - Municipal, county, and township roads are a priority
- Trail counters and pneumatic tube counters for bicycles are also available.

Major Trips 2017

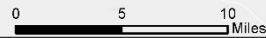
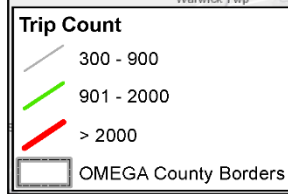
