



Transportation Advisory Committee Meeting

April 15, 2020

OMEGA Conference Call

Meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. A list of attendees is attached. Mr. Brian Wise, P.E., P.S. asked attendees to introduce themselves. Ms. Jill Lengler motioned to approve the minutes. Mr. Fred Wachtel, P.E., P.S. seconded the motion.

Mr. Kevin Buettner provided an update on the 2021-2024 RTP, including where OMEGA is at in the process and information on the public involvement. Public meetings were conducted via Facebook Live. Recordings of both meetings are available on OMEGA's Facebook and YouTube page. The draft plan is available on OMEGA's website for review and comment. Interactive programmed project maps are also available on OMEGA's website.

Mr. Buettner reviewed major activities of the FY 2021 Work Plan. Major activities include the development of a Regional Safety Plan, the recalibration of a Tri-County Active Transportation Plan, the creation of an Executive Summary of the Long-Range Transportation Plan, and the development of interactive web-based maps for transportation projects.

Mr. Buettner provided an update on the Long-Range Transportation Plan, including an overview of the goals and objectives, trends, and existing transportation system.

Mr. Buettner provided an update on and options for the RFQ. Approximately \$28,000 will be available for planning projects. The potential projects discussed were the Traffic Impact/Safety Study on Tusky Valley Road (CR 106) (Total Project Cost \$15,000) and the Holmes County Hazard Identification (Trees in ROW) Project (Total Project Cost \$49,000). OMEGA will retain the consultant for the RFQ. The group discussed the options for funding one project completely and/or partially funding another. Mr. Wachtel motioned to fund the Tusky Valley Road project completely and use the rest of the funds to offset the Holmes County project. Mr. Bachman seconded the motion.

Mr. Buettner provided announcements on upcoming meetings, speakers, and grant deadlines

Mr. Wachtel motioned to approve sending the FY 2021 Work Plan on to the next step. Ms. Lengler seconded the motion.

Ms. Lengler motioned to submit the 2021-2024 RTIP to the Executive Board for approval. Mr. Nathan Troyer seconded the motion.
