



One Call/One Click Strategic Planning Initiative



Result:

Access Tuscarawas, 501c3, is seeking funding to establish the revised Mobility Solutions Center. This will be a regional transportation call center and information source for all transportation options in each regional county as well as providing other informational and support features.

Employment Transportation Feasibility Study



Result: Four potential employment transportation routes were developed in and around Coshocton. Two of the routes were viable enough to be considered for pilot programs.

Result: The Region 9 Resource Guide was available online beginning October 16, 2021.


Views to the site have increased monthly from 74 to over 300 per month with an almost even split between returning viewers and new viewers.



Results:

Each county utilized an equal monetary apportionment for county specific marketing outreach. In addition, two public service announcements featuring all public transits in the region were produced. The actors in the commercials were all current transit employees and riders. The 30 second and 60 second spots were featured on social media platforms throughout the region and shown on local tv stations. They remain available to anyone who wishes to view or share them.


