

Announcements, comments, or updates?

FTA published a <u>notice</u> in the Federal Register seeking comment on a proposed Buy America Waiver for transit vans and minivans. Under FTA's proposal, FTA would grant a partial Buy America waiver of limited duration for transit agencies to procure massproduced, **unmodified non-ADA accessible passenger vans and minivans**. FTA is requesting public and industry comment on whether to grant the waiver as proposed, or in a modified form. FTA is proposing that this partial waiver would expire after two years, or when a compliant vehicle becomes available, whichever is first.

Comments are due by Wednesday, August 3. Omega sent all members the announcement with a link to provide comments.
