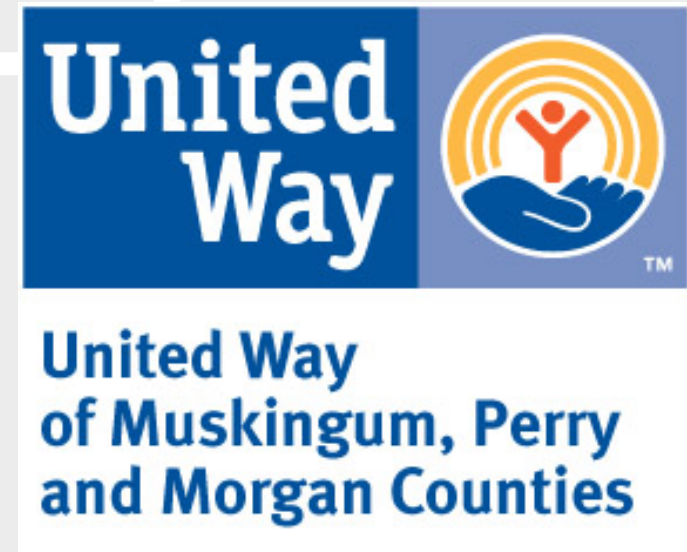
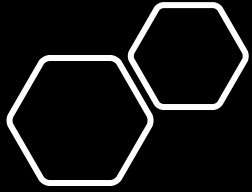

Health

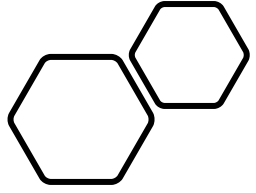
Improving People's Health and Wellness

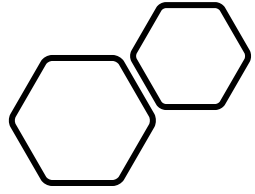

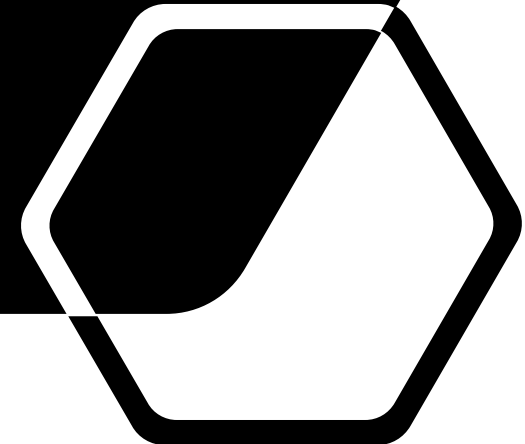
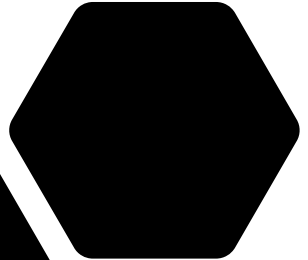
Impact Story

Bill reached out to the Muskingum Mobility Manager requesting out of county medical transportation to Cleveland Clinic for his pre op knee surgery appointment. Bill had a vehicle but was unable to drive due to his knee injury. He was on disability and could not afford the \$120 round trip fare to Cleveland. However, was also over income eligibility to qualify for Medicaid. He was worried he was going to have to cancel his appointment or worse, use the money he had budgeted for groceries just to get there. He knew he would have more than just this one appointment to Cleveland. By receiving the Community Impact Grant, Mobility Management was able to transport Bill to his appointments at no cost to him. He was able to get his surgery without the worry of going without food or essentials he needs on a limited income.

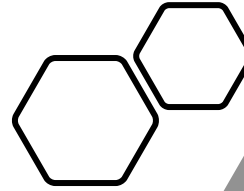

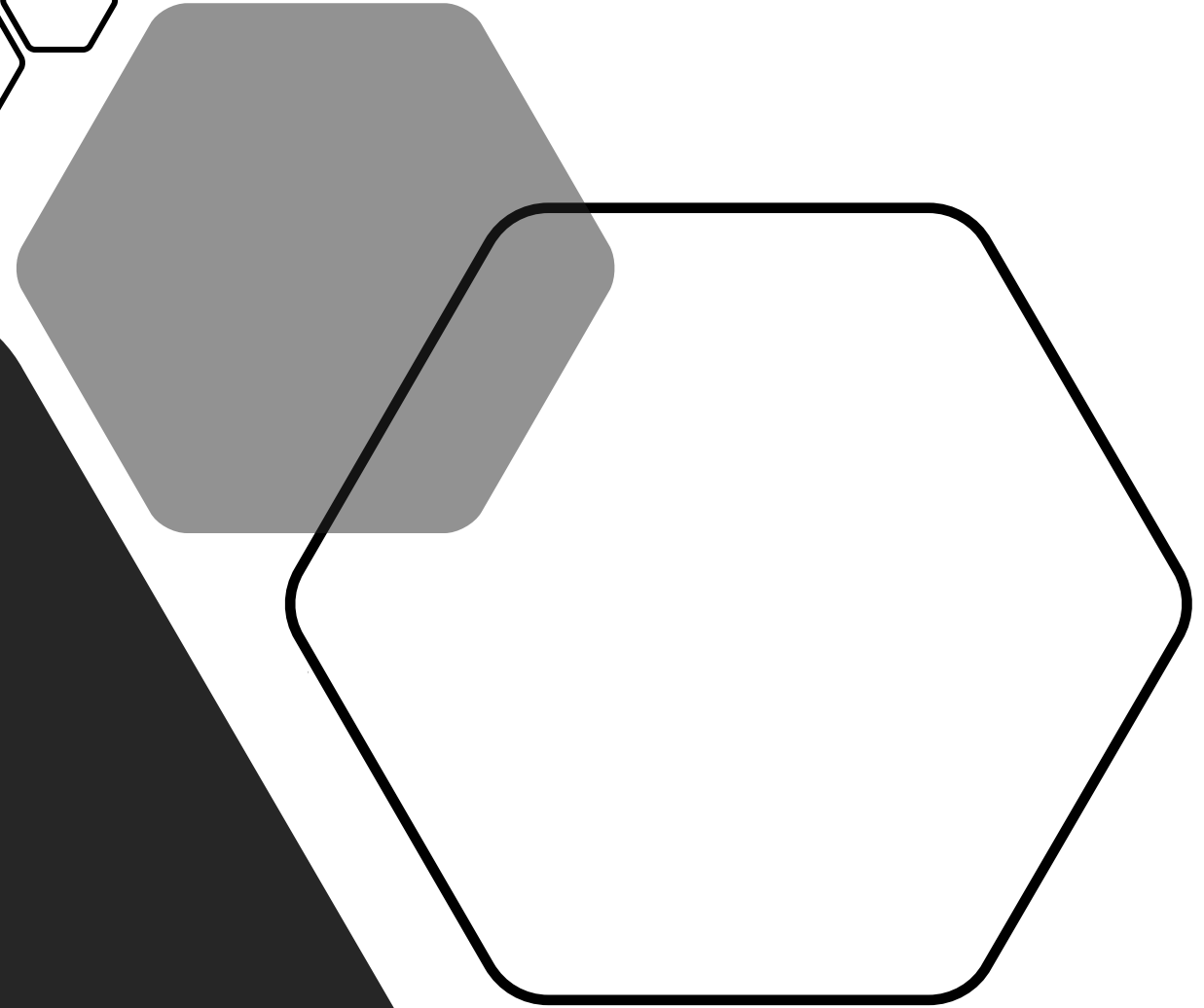

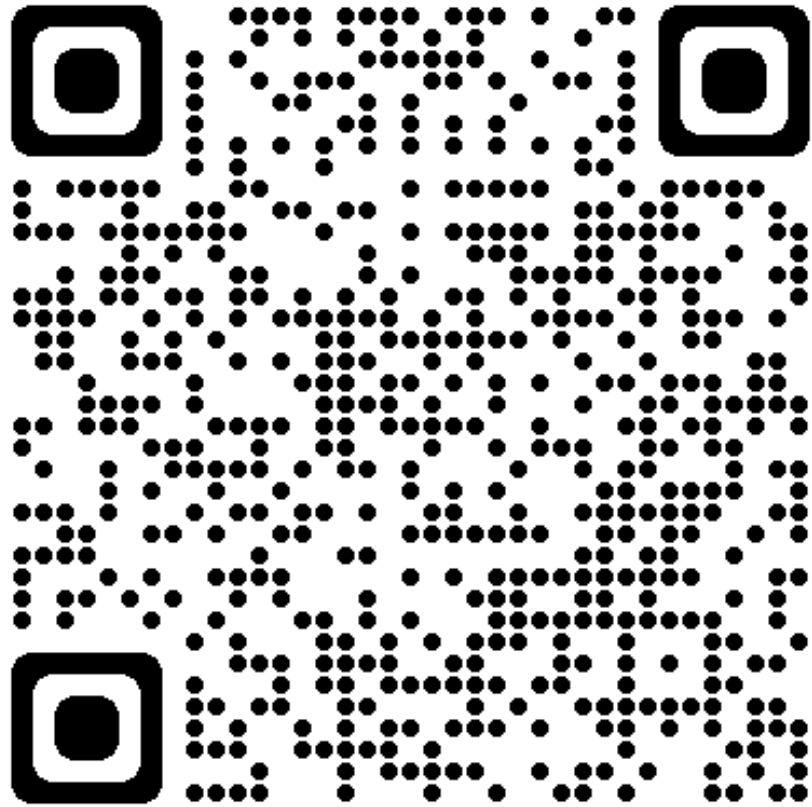
