

# 2022 Regional Survey of Unmet Needs

**2068** responses – more than a 10% increase from last year!

60 % of respondents are seniors:

39% are 65-80 21% are 80 and over


77% drive or are being driven13% use public transit6% use agency transportation (senior centers, etc.)

41% ride public transit 1-4x/month 23% ride public transit 2-4x/week


20% still have trouble getting a ride outside their county

32% use a mobility device


#### What additional accommodations would make it easier to access transportation?
