



## **Transportation Advisory Committee Meeting**

**January 27, 2021**

### **OMEGA Zoom Meeting**

Meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. Acting Chairman Mr. Tom Konst asked attendees to introduce themselves.

Mr. Fred Wachtel, P.E., P.S. motioned to approve the minutes. Mr. Joe Bachman, P.E., P.S seconded the motion.

Mr. Kevin Buettner reviewed the proposed projects available for the TAC's consideration: the East Liverpool 4-Lane Feasibility study (\$9,800), Guernsey County Road Condition Inventory (\$7,500), and the Lisbon Trailhead-Downtown Connection (\$5,000). Mr. Buettner also reviewed the score sheet for the projects. The consensus from the TAC was to approve the Guernsey County project and to gather more information about the Lisbon project.

Mr. Wachtel motioned to authorize the Guernsey County Road Condition Inventory project; the East Liverpool 4-Lane Feasibility study and the Lisbon Trailhead-Downtown Connection project can be on the list if they hit the targets the TAC has laid out. Ms. Lengler seconded the motion. Mr. Buettner will provide an update at the March meeting.

Mr. Buettner reviewed the grant announcements.

Mr. Buettner reviewed the eligible townships for the Township Sign grant. If a township has a village that goes through the eligible township, the village is also eligible for funding; the township must be the applicant. Each township is eligible for up to \$50,000 in safety signs, posts, and hardware. Townships must complete a virtual training of about 1.5 hours total; the training must be completed before the application is submitted.

Mr. Konst adjourned the meeting at 10:30 a.m. Next meeting is on March 17, 2021 at 10:00 a.m.
