Proposed Projects

East Liverpool 4-Lane Feasibility

Project Applicant: City of East Liverpool CIC

Funding Request: \$9,800

Summary: Hire a consultant to conduct a feasibility study to develop supporting documentation for the preliminary planning, feasibility assessment, and fiscal programming to construct a four-lane highway connecting Ohio State Route 11 to I-376 in Vanport, PA (near Monaca)

Supports Regional Goal:

Facilitate Economic & Community Development

Limitations:

Planning funds may only be used for Ohio portion.

Proposed Projects

East Liverpool Trail Planning (REMOVED)

Project Applicant: City of East Liverpool

Funding Request: \$15,000

Summary: Hire a consultant to conduct an engineering feasibility study to develop a hike/bike trail along the Ohio River from the City of East Liverpool's eastern boundary to downtown East Liverpool.

Supports Regional Goal:

Facilitate Economic & Community Development

Limitations:

Contractor should be retained through OMEGA for easier funding administration, in accordance with federal procurement requirements.

Proposed Projects

Guernsey County Road Condition Inventory

Project Applicant: Guernsey County Highway Department

Funding Request: \$7,500

Summary: Hire an intern to document, measure, and summarize a variety of conditions in a manageable system that can be cross-referenced with crash data and other reports to identify areas that need improved.

Supports Regional Goal:

Preserve Regional Assets to Support Local Economies

Increase the Safety of Regional Infrastructure

Develop & Maintain Regional Resiliency

Limitations:

State planning funds may not be used unless a portion of the state system is included in the project. Otherwise, either the total project cost must be \$8,334 (or greater) or a 10% local match required.

Proposed Projects

Lisbon Trailhead-Downtown Connection

Project Applicant: Village of Lisbon

Funding Request: \$5,000

Summary: Hire a consultant to analyze the village and trail system to determine how to better use the trail to boost the local economy. This report would include signage and infrastructure recommendations, and other potential solutions.
